MARTIAL ARTS PROFILE MUDADA DRUMMOND-



Grand Master Mudada Drummond a **9th Degree Grand Master Black Belt** started his combative and self-defense training in the United States Army in **1964**. He also received fourteen months of special combat training in Korea and earned the title of Sergeant (1964 – 1966).

He has eight years (1980 – 1988) of Martial Arts Training in a highly respected martial art called Vita Saana / African Martial Arts. He earned his Black Belt under Vita Saana Founder Mwanza Umeme Mpingo (JC).

In 1990 he started studying Shotokan and Kyokushinkai under Grandmaster Robert Dickerson (UPK); he received his **1st Degree Black Belt** on July 25, 1992, **3rd Degree Black Belt** on January 27, 1995, **5th Degree Master Black Belt** on June 22, 2003 and his **6th Degree Master Black Belt** on September 18, 2005. Every Martial Arts School witnesses the joy and benefit of having the great Elder Grand Master Mudada Drummond help them make champions and upright positive citizens representing the value of the Martial Arts.

In 1995 his job relocate to Richmond VA.; with permission from his Grandmaster while in Richmond he continued to studied the arts in Richmond VA. He studied TAE Know Do under Sensei Lacey (1995 – 1996).

In 1996 thru 2001 he found a dojo that taught the Shotokan and Kyokushinkai styles of karate. He studied, trained and taught the style Horshin under Master Harry Crump. Upon Master Harry Crump retirement from the Arts he continued to study Judo under Sensei Leo Valdes and Tai Chi under Shi Fu Albert Yee.

He returned to New Jersey in 2002 and continued to teach under Grandmaster Robert Dickerson (UPK). Today, Grand Master Drummond is teaching and supporting many young Martial Art students in Universal Pasha Karate (UPK), and Vita Saana.

Grandmaster Walter Mudada Drummond has been inducted into **many prestigious World Martial Arts Hall of Fames for his dedicated in the Martial Arts**. As an elder Grand Master Martial Artists in his 80's, he is continuing to strive for perfection while teaching, demonstrating and directing in the Martial Arts.
